## **ABOUT R.B.S. COLLEGE**

Hon'ble Balwant Singh Ji, the Raja of Awagarh estate, a great Administrator and philanthropist in the field of education started Rajput High School in 1885 at Agra with a donation of Rs. 9,00,000/- which has now grown into magnificent Raja Balwant Singh College. Balwant Rajput Intermediate College was the first in Uttar Pradesh to have faculties of Arts, Commerce, Science, and Agriculture. An education wing was started and in 1943 & it was raised to postgraduate level. It is Oldest College in India to commence M. Sc. Agriculture and known as the first to start study of SEED STRUCTURE in India. Architecture of Bichpuri Agriculture campus was designed by an Italian Architect. Mr. DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER the first US president, who visited India, came to this college with former Indian Prime Minister Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru. R.B.S. College, Agra has nine faculties -- Arts, Commerce, Education, Science, Agriculture, Engineering and Technology, Pharmacy and Management and Computer Application. There are five campuses -- three in Agra and Bichpuri and one in Awagarh. The Bichpuri Campus of the college has developed into an institution of advanced learning, training and research: it includes the Balwant Rural Institute, the Bichpuri Farm, and departments in agriculture, farm management and extension education in the surrounding villages in liaison with Block level organizations. The college has a remarkable range of research infrastructure and facilities such as well-equipped laboratories, The college has been carrying out high quality researches in the All India coordinated research projects of ICAR DST/ DBT/ UGC/ DAE/ MHRD(UBA)/ ICMR/MoES sponsored projects in the fields of Nanotechnology, Biotechnology, Agriculture, Physics, Seismology, Commerce, Education, Plant Systematics, Chemistry, Political Science, Botany, Instrumentation, Environmental Sciences, cultural heritage etc. It is the Only College in India to have - 4 All India Coordinated Research Projects of ICAR & Min. of Agri. And 2 ICAR sponsored Krishi Vigyan Kendras , PL-480 scheme, USAID, Rockefeller Foundation grant. It still has Bilateral exchange International collaborated projects under DST grants with Italy, Japan, Hungary, Germany and Russia. It is the first college to be recognized by

the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (D.S.I.R.), New Delhi from 2007 onwards. Department of Botany is DST-FIST sponsored department. College is having –DST & Dept. of Earth Sciences sponsored Seismo-electromagnetics & Space Research Laboratory. KVK, agriculture departments, Botany department and Engineering faculties are involved in consultancy. It is the feeder college for universities/ Agriculture universities/departments /ICAR institutes and prestigious institutions in the country. The College was granted College for Potential Excellence in 2004 by UGC, New Delhi. Based on its meritorious achievements and academic legacy, this heritage college was accredited with grade A+ by NAAC in 2017- CGPA 3.56. The college is worldwide known for its contribution in Agriculture and Biological Sciences. The college has initiated 4 Diploma and 3 B.Voc. courses under NSQF program sponsored by University Grants Commission resulting into establishment of NEW PARADIGM – “**Raja Balwant Singh Community College**” in its group of Institutions. A Talking library is established for visually impaired. MHRD scheme under IIT-Delhi on **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan** is also running in two campuses of the College under which 5 villages each have been adopted for survey, technology dissemination and development. It is the only college having many commercialized innovations to its credit in association with industrial partners.
